

Create a Technical File. Step 3 - Matching Requirements and Documents

Now the collected evidence has to be linked to the requirements.

Select the relevant requirements and link documents that show compliance with this requirement. Or start at the other side by opening a document in the build-in secure viewer and match it with the relevant requirements.

Starting at the documents is the preferred route. Our integrated MatchIt tool will look into the document, if the format of the document allows it, and will detect which requirements from the requirement list to "Match" if there is a possible match. This saves time and enhances the quality of the review of documents.

We offer two levels of matching;
more needed to sign off this requirement
this is sufficient to sign off this requirement

One document can be used to sign off multiple requirements. Multiple documents can be linked to one requirement.
